Then, we found out she had hemangioma and had to have surgery every 6 weeks. The worry and stress were more than I could take, I relapsed. Gracie got sick and passed away in her sleep from croup. Her father and I weren't living right and got taken to jail for drug paraphernalia. It was the worst pain I'd ever felt losing my only daughter, and having to grieve and mourn in jail. I was so sad, angry, scared, and broken. Jesus helped me through the pain and God opened a door for me to come to Project New Start. Here I'm finally getting help for my problems and making the necessary changes for my life so that I have a bright future. I've been sober now for a year with God and Project New Start I have a new beginning.

My name is Tyler Reed, I am a 35 year old ex-drug addict, turned around by the grace of God. I have been lost in anxiety and depression, which led me to self medicate. The past few years of my life, I did drugs to escape reality and the pain. I came to Project New Start to get help with it all. After being here for a while and allowing my head to clear up, I could focus on what really matters, Jesus Christ, my Lord and Savior. God has lifted me out of the fog and set me back where I am suppose to be. I am a blessed man with God's love all around me. I am so excited to continue my walk with God.
